## **Q: How much does it cost to attend Student Days?**

A: There is no cost to attend MODEX or Student Days. The costs for the event are sponsored by MHI, MHI's Career and Technical Education Program, the College Industry Council on Material Handling Education (CICMHE), the Material Handling Education Foundation, Inc. (MHEFI) and the Material Handling Equipment Distributors Association (MHEDA).
